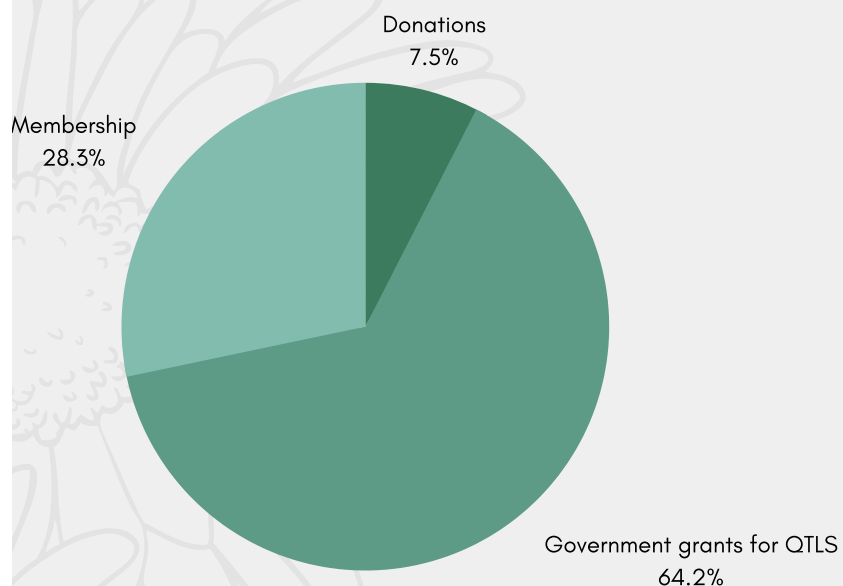

First chart is indicative of review from 2019.

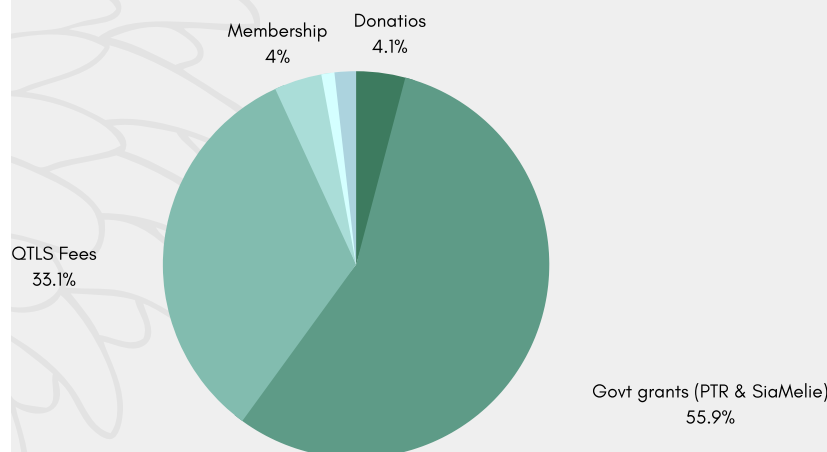

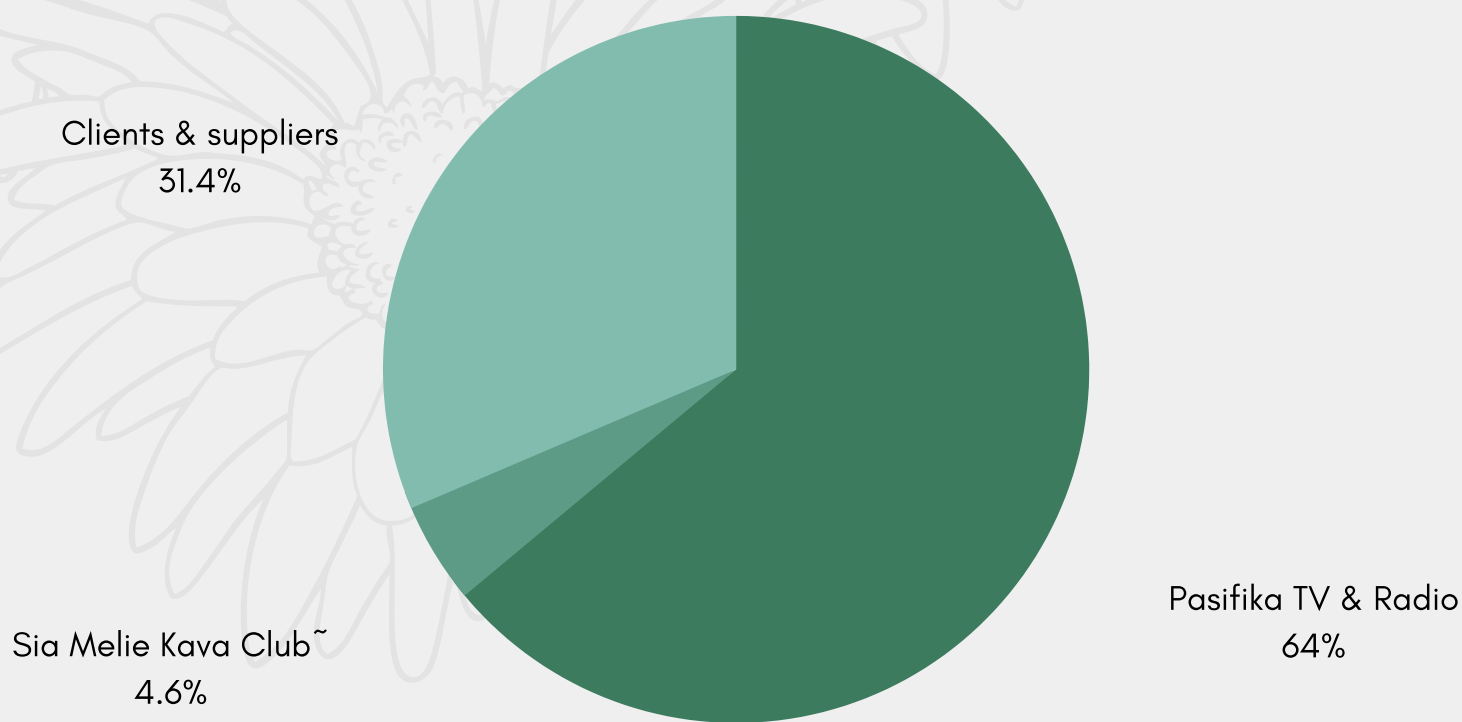

29 AUG 2019

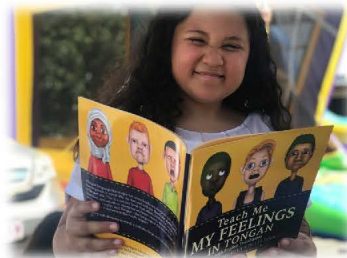
